**Here's what we got done in All Saints Strategic Process Year Three (2021):**

Prepared and executed a program to understand better and reach out to underrepresented demographic groups at All Saints

This was accomplished by a multi-phased series called Understanding Ourselves and Others.

The series focused primarily on African-American and young people and those who saved All Saints. It was accomplished by four Commissions developing and presenting themed programs on Zoom that were open to All Saints members and invited outside groups. The themes included the early history of All Saints and the enslaved people who built it, music of the Civil War era and its significance, saving All Saints in the late 40s and 50s, how the church could better meet the needs of young people. The commissions that gave presentations are Giving Back, Worship, Living Our Values and Parish Family Life. Each presentation included a discussion moderated by a representative from the Community Mediation Center of Calvert County.

Continued to advise church leadership on societal issues warranting a public response, mainly by letters to the editor, based upon our core values and broad consensus of members.

Explored the possibility of a church memorial to the enslaved people who built All Saints and those who have faithfully supported it and served Christ here. Obtained Vestry substantive approval. Now working on design details.

As Chair, I must highly commend the members of our commission. They continue to be exemplary both in the quality of their work and in their devotion to the All Saints community and commitment to seek God's will for the future of All Saints.

Looking forward, we will work closely with other commission/committees and leaders to make our core values and church motto, "Loving our neighbors" a reality in all we do.

The commission will continue to act as an advisory body to the Rector and church leaders on appropriate and effective responses to societal issues when needed.

We will continue to support the Calvert Concept, principal housing mission.

Updated the Parish Directory. We have transitioned from print-based to an electronic format. The updated church directory will be completed in February 2022, and it will also include an update on pictures.

Mailed handcrafted holiday cards to the sick and shut in and cards to parishioners with special needs.

Mailed handcrafted birthday cards monthly to parishioners.

Recognized high school and college graduates (gave crosses and gift cards) in a ceremony in the labyrinth).

Hosted a special farewell in the labyrinth for Patrick and Lisa Herlihy and planted a hydrangea in honor of them.

Provided ongoing wellness checks for homebound parishioners and/or for parishioners with special needs.

Provided emergency assistance to parishioners in need.

Blessed backpacks, schools, and children on the steps of the Calvert County Board of Education.

Hosted Blessing of the Animals and Animal Parade Service and made donations to the Calvert Humane Society.

Monitored the All Saints Helpline during the health crisis.

Hosted a virtual discussion/conversation with our youth about their feelings about church and how they could become more active in church activities. The Youth Conversation took place in January 2022.

Here's what we got done in All Saints Strategic Process Year Three (2021):

Provided the Vestry with recommendations for allocation of the Parish Outreach tithe to charities and, with the Treasurer, executed the Parish Outreach program of \$24,000; additional donations brought the total given for others to about \$33,000. Some details follow.

Provided the Vestry with recommended charities to be the beneficiaries of the Calvert Arts Festival 2022.

Donations let us nearly double our planned donations to the CCC Food Pantry to about \$6000.

Through special projects the Committee raised over \$2000 for outreach; the CAF raised over \$6,500 for five community charities.

We collected over 2,000 pounds of food for the Food Pantry and fulfilled our obligation to support the Food Pantry for the Month of May.

As part of the HeartFELT program, we provided Backpacks of food sufficient for each weekend of the school year, feeding 17 children attending our Sponsored School (Beach Elementary). (Due to COVID Relief programs for families our numbers reduced some but are expected to again increase.)

We provided financial assistance for Rent and Utilities for 20 people and prevented 6 evictions by partnering with Parish Partners and Social Services.

We provide Meals to Project ECHO monthly, and Drivers for Meals on Wheels as needed.

Coordinated gifts of food baskets for those in need at Christmas and Thanksgiving.

Thanks to Hillary Dailey, the Angel tree providing scores of Christmas gifts to children.

Our Parish provided volunteers to support our LDS Partner's bulk food project for children.

Our volunteers were not needed this year for the Safe Nights homeless program, but we expect to renew in-person involvement next year.

By coordinating and matching funds with Community Ministry of Calvert County, other churches, and civic organizations we were able to multiply the beneficial effects of All Saints' funding for those in need.

Knitting group met weekly via Zoom and, therefore, included women who had moved out of area and those who just wanted to chat. The group has created and given away more than 400 prayers shawls in its 17 years, all blessed by our Rector.

Provided refreshments for volunteers at spring and fall campus clean-ups.

Paid for supplies for the Altar Guild, Kitchen Repairs, COVID sanitation supplies and masks.

Donated to vestry for church's expenses.

Provided refreshments of pre-packaged snacks and beverages for coffee time between services when permitted under COVID protocols.

Members provided books for Reading Camp.

At Calvert Arts Festival, raised funds through sales at Backdoor Café, crafts and bake sale tables. Made wine/beer cozies to sell at Administration Table.

Submitted public service announcements and paid advertising for ECW and church events with media in local counties to publicize our events.

Planned, organized, and held the Christmas Market, with Lissi Mojica as our new chair. Many members baked and created items for ECW tables.

Helped set up Father Ken's Retirement Reception and provided refreshments.

Parish upgrade of Sacristy and Choir room HVAC systems

Rectory repairs of second floor bathroom

Rectory upgrade of two new HVAC systems and water heater which replaced aging oil furnace.

Rectory refresh with over 120 items completed to prepare the home for Father Andrew's arrival. It looks fabulous thanks to all the volunteers and financial assistance which helped us to complete a broad spectrum of work from major items like floor refinishing, painting, repairs, to minor items such as a deep cleaning and lighting.

Accomplished a variety of maintenance and repairs to the Parish, Parish Hall and Rectory including electrical, lighting, plumbing, septic, cosmetics

Campus ground cleanups in Spring, before Calvert Arts Festival and Fall. All were very successful thanks to volunteers from All Saints and our neighboring Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints (LDS).

Worked with All Saints leaders and LDS to start discussion on joint outreach and mission work (e.g., Spudnik, Puerto Rico Mission, LDS Haiti food pack which yielded over 30,000 packs).

Continued to maintain a prioritized list of campus maintenance and upgrades needed

The Calvert Concept non-profit fund has been established and is fully operational under the umbrella of Chesapeake Charities.

A Facebook page and a website "landing page" have been established.

Two public meetings were held to address interest within the community to either sit on the board or one of the established committees outlined in the Calvert Concepts draft Bylaws.
